Subject: Club Sessions

Patriot Ice Club includes a diverse group of skaters — competitive and recreational, adults and children. All our sessions include mixed skill levels; we have skaters working on double axels sharing the space with beginners just learning to master crossovers. And, we usually have a variety of activities going on all at once as well... freestyle, MIF, and even dance lessons.

All skaters, no matter what their level, are expected to share the space cooperatively with the other skaters. Our advanced skaters know they must respect the lower-level skaters who are less maneuverable and try not to intimidate them. Conversely, our low-level skaters are taught to be aware of other's skating programs and to avoid being roadblocks.

No one skater or class of skaters is permitted to monopolize the music system. A skater, any level, who has not had his/her music played has priority over a skater going for the second or third run through. No more than two pro cuts are permitted between skaters in the regular music queue.

Our coaches are expected to instill in their skaters an attitude of mutual respect and courtesy towards other skaters on the ice. Our professional staff does an excellent job of teaching these values along with skating, and the result is mixed-level sessions that run smoothly. The strong skaters continue to improve and advance their skating while they inspire rather than intimidate the beginner skaters.

To prospective coaches: If you and your skaters can be comfortable functioning in a mixed-level, mixed-activity environment such as we have at Patriot, we would very much look forward to receiving your application to join our staff.

And to our current coaches: Thank you for helping the club maintain this mutually respectful and supportive environment. Keep up the good work!
